## BACKGROUND/PROPOSAL:

Dwayne Buchholtz of the Peace Valley Snow Riders has requested that Council grant permission to be added to the current Hines Creek and Attractions signage.

The Peace Valley Snow Riders have made application to TODS (Tourist Oriented Directional Signs) to place three signs (see below and attached map) for the staging area for the Hines Creek Trail.

1. Parking area for staging area for Hines Creek Trail just off government
2. Highway 685 into Hines Creek
3. Highway 64 into Hines Creek

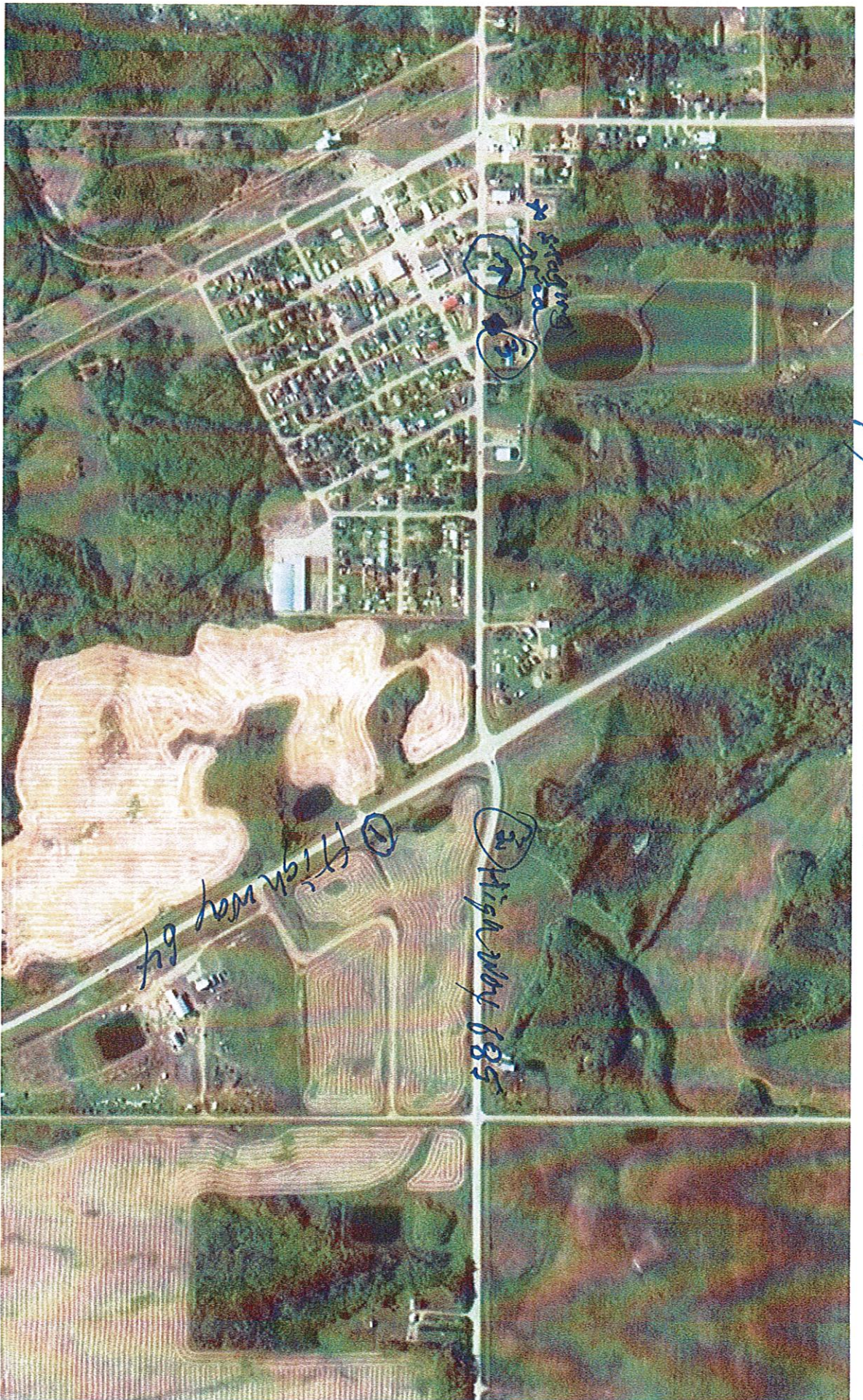
Being as number 1 is located within the community limits there is different sign placement criteria as legislated by CAF (Community Attractions Facility Sign)

As per Edward Chin of Tourism Highway Signage Program, before the club can erect the staging area sign within the Villages boundaries they MUST be added to the current Hines Creek and Attractions Sign. To have this happen one of the symbols would have to be replaced as there is only room for six symbols on the sign or the middle plaque that reads “End of Steel Museum” could be changed to read “Peace Valley Snow Riders”.
