

BYLAW NO. 577-18

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF HINES CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF THE HINES CREEK SNOW RIDERS TRAIL WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HINES CREEK.

WHEREAS The Traffic Safety Act being Chapter T-6 and the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, both of the Statutes of Alberta as amended provides that a Municipal Council may enact a Bylaw respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property, for the joint usage for a Snowmobile trail within the Village of Hines Creek boundaries.

WHEREAS: Section 7 (b) of the Municipal Act provides that a Council may pass a Bylaw respecting services provided on behalf of the Municipality, and

WHEREAS: The Council of the Village of Hines Creek wishes to enter into an agreement with the Peace Valley Snow Riders Club for the establishment and operation of a Snow Riders Trail within the Village of Hines Creek boundaries.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HINES CREEK IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED

1. The Village of Hines Creek will enter into an agreement with the Peace Valley Snow Riders Club for the establishment and operation of a Snowmobile Trail within the boundaries of the Village.

2. This Bylaw shall take effect on the day of its final passing.

READ, a first time this 13 day of February, 2018.

READ, a second time this 13 day of February, 2018.

Given UNANIMOUS consent to go to third reading on this 13 day of February, 2018.

READ, a third time and finally passed this 13 day of February, 2018.
