BACKGROUND INFORMATION

April 29, 2019 -Bylaw Enforcement Officer Kim Kuntz received complaint of a dog attack from Veronica Walmsley:

On April 26, 2019 at approximately 5:00 p.m. Stephen Belhommes dog housed at 920-6th Avenue entered the yard of Veronica Walmsley at 919-6th Avenue and attacked their dog which was tethered by chain in the back yard.

April 29, 2019 Kuntz spoke with Belhomme via phone regarding the attack.

April 29, 2019 Kuntz issued a letter and Violation Ticket No. 0001 in the amount of \$500.00 to Stephen Belhomme.
