The Municipal Stimulus Program Agreement with Municipal Affairs was signed after the last Council meeting

C-280-20 RESOLUTION by Councillor Bjornson to enter into an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen represented by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the implantation of the Municipal Stimulus Program. CARRIED.

I spoke with Jeff Sulymka from Municipal Affairs on August 26, 2020.

Allocation is \$50,000.00 (one time program). We have 2 years to spend the money but the deadline for projects is October 1, 2020. There will be no other projects being awarded after the deadline.

Projects we outlined

- 1. Upgrade Water Treatment Plant Qualifies
- 2. Bulk Water Valve replacement Qualifies (stay away from the credit card portion of a project like this as it is not covered)
- 3. Roof Top Furnace Qualifies
- 4. Lagoon Fencing Qualifies
- 5. Backup Generators for Lift Station and Arena Qualifies

Projects will be prioritized by making sure there is job creation involved.

North Peace Gas was contacted and supplied the Village with the following:

Furnace cost: $$7000.00 \times 2 = $14,000.00$ Picker truck: $$230/hr \times 5 \text{ hrs} = 1150.00

Total: \$15,150.00


