BACKGROUND/PROPOSAL:

Our Fitness Center Facilitator has brought to our attention that lights and ceiling tiles are occasionally hit by basketballs at the fitness center when a ball bounces off the rim at the wrong angle.

Currently there are fluorescent hanging lights that could break if hit by a ball. The Village does have leftover LED lights from the lighting project that could be installed that would be flush with the ceiling. Which would potentially save the lights, but damage to the ceiling tiles is still a possibility.

Another option is to suspend a net above the basketball net to protect the lights and the tiles, public works estimates a 30'x 30' net would cover the required area.


