In May 2011, Prairie Disposal Ltd completed its new 36000sqft facility and is capable of handling all types of recyclables. We are currently processing 700+ Metric Tonnes of product per month. Project Overview

Prairie Disposal Ltd. will assign two dedicated and trained drivers to the awarded contract along with an experienced and capable Project Management Team. To ensure smooth operation all Prairie Disposal Ltd. employees are cross trained on all equipment that is being operated for services. This ensures that any unexpected sick days or required time off does not interfere with collection of the garbage.

Our office is well equipped to handle complaints or any incidents. Prairie Disposal Ltd. employs three full time Dispatchers (Lead Dispatcher - Tammy Savidan; 13yr employee), three office admins (Office Manager -Diane Davis; 24yr employee), Safety Supervisor (Joanne Laver; 18yr employee), Operations Manager (Bart Wisekal; 17yr employee), and General Manager (Erik Jorgensen; 20yr employee) to ensure that no complaints are missed and any incidents are fixed within a timely manner.

Equipment Description:

Prairie Disposal Ltd., if awarded this contract, would utilize a 2019 Freightliner Tandem Axle Chassis equipped with Labrie Side Loader body. Our trucks are equipped with drop frames with standup right hand drive systems for quick and easy access for the drivers to get in and out of the trucks. The low entry height into the cab reduces impact on the drivers so that it reduces fatigue and the chance of injuries. The hopper is also low so that the drivers do not have to reach far to throw the bags into the truck also reducing fatigue and chance for injuries. The trucks are equipped with rear and side camera systems to increase the driver's visibility which is key when working in congested residential areas. As well as making it possible to make it so the drivers can see potential hazards better, our trucks are equipped with a backup alarm, strobe light, backup lights, and LED lights so that the public can see and hear better what our trucks and drivers are doing.

In an emergency situation, Prairie Disposal Ltd. has an additional fourteen residential units that it can draw from to ensure undisrupted service.

All of Prairie Disposal Ltd.'s Residential Units are Manual/Automated Side Loader trucks. Thus enabling Prairie Disposal Ltd. to service the residential contract either as a manual or fully automated as per the contracts requirements.
